Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir State Rural Livelihoods Mission has been entrusted with the implementation of the Skill Development Programme viz. HIMAYAT by designating it as Action Plan State under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya- Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) financed by Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India;

Whereas, consequent upon the above decision this Mission submitted Action Plan to the Ministry which was approved at a cost of Rs.1601.51 crores with 100 percent Central share from the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India covering a target to skill training and placement of 1,24,180 youth;

Whereas, Project Applications were invited under the programme from prospective Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs) for providing of training and employment to youth;

Whereas, vide Government Order No.257-RD&PR of 2016 dated 07.09.2016 issued by the Department of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Jammu and Kashmir and accordingly National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Hyderabad (NIRD) was engaged as Central Technical Support Agency (CTSA)/Project Appraisal Agency for appraisal/evaluation of proposals of PIAs;

Whereas, Project Applications were appraised and recommended by the National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Hyderabad (NIRD) for providing of training to youth under different trades;

Whereas, vide notification no. 17/2017 dated 23.03.2017 and letter no. F. No. 17064/04/2017 dated 18.05.2017, Rural Skills Division, Deptt. Of Rural Development, MoRD, GoI

stated that the States may consider sanction of additional targets to PIAs with proven performance in the state.

Whereas, the proposals of the "better performing PIAs" were placed before the State Level Project Review Committee (SLPRC) in its second meeting held on 28-07-2017 and subsequently in its third meeting held on 13-09-2017, and the committee approved eight proposals of four PIAs for additional Targets, including of M/S Don Bosco Tech Society. The minutes of the said meeting was issued under endorsement No. COO/JKSRLM/HMT/06/2016 dated 19-09-2017;

Whereas, M/S Don Bosco Tech Society has set-up four training centres, located one each at Delhi, Lucknow, Baramulla and Samba with a total training capacity of 305 conforming to the Notification 53/2017 of Ministry of Rural Development, GoI which stated that minimum capacity of the training centres has to be at least 10% of project target (2735);

Now, therefore, sanction is hereby accorded to the allotment of Project under HIMAYAT (DDU-GKY) Programme in favour of "M/S Don Bosco Tech Society" (bearing PRN: DL2013RF1089 and proposal code DL2013RF108920170607122017) for providing training and placement to youth as per the details given below:
